



## **Ravvi's School of Yoga**

**Assessment Criteria:** Assessment is based on the five criteria stated below:-

- a) **Student conducts** throughout the training (Yoga ethics, behavior to self and others, cleanliness, awareness, reactions, speech, temperament, habits etc.)
- b) **Karma Yoga Practice** (Willingness and taking Initiative, skill in action, how the practice of selfless service is performed etc.)
- c) **Completion of assignments** (Prompt, clear, relative, specific etc.)
- d) **Personal practice and performance** (Interest, motivation, enthusiasm and ability to perform, mental attitude etc.)
- e) **Guiding a class** (Involvement, clarity of the dialogues, sequencing, ability to guide the class, precautions etc.)

Student Behavior will be observed throughout the training.

Karma Yoga Practice will be observed throughout the training.

All assignments are based on to demonstrate the understanding of the concept. It is mandatory to present all assignments to the trainer, assignments will be assessed by the trainer based on the understanding of the concept.

The trainer will assess the performance of your personal yoga practice based on the interest, motivation, enthusiasm mental attitude and ability to perform in the right manner.

The trainer or the guest teacher will evaluate your guiding the class based on the involvement, clarity of the dialogues, precautions, sequencing and ability to guide the class.

Training Instructor/Director of the course time to time will issue an evaluation note based on the student performance for the above stated five criteria specifying **Good / Need Improvement**. At the end of the course to pass the training a student must have evaluation note stating **Good** in all five criteria. Student with evaluation note of **Need Improvement** in any/all of five criteria will **not be qualified for certification**. If student has **Need Improvement** evaluation note, he/she should contact the training Instructor/Director for the guidelines to upgrade the evaluation.

**Minimum 95% attendance required for certification**

**For certification, a student must pass the assessment criteria.**
